#### **EVENT 1: THINKATHON 2.0**

## Tagline:

Two Minds. One Vision. Infinite Possibilities.

## **Event Description:**

Thinkathon 2.0 is a **duo brainstorming hackathon** where creativity, logic, and teamwork collide. Each team of two will choose their **own problem statement on the spot**, brainstorm a feasible techdriven solution, and present it within a given **PPT format provided by the organizers**. It's not about how well you code — it's about **how smartly you think** and **how clearly you pitch your innovation**.

**Event Duration:** Total – 3 Hours

## Round 1 – Ideation Sprint (Shortlisting Round)

Time: 60 minutes

**Goal:** Identify and define the problem with a creative, feasible solution outline.

### **What Happens:**

- Teams brainstorm and finalize their problem statement on the spot.
- They complete only the **first half of the PPT template** (Problem, Proposed Idea, and Target Audience).
- Submit their brief for shortlisting.

# **Judging Focus:**

- Relevance of problem
- Originality of idea
- Clarity of thought

#### Outcome:

Top **8–10 teams** move to the final round.

### Round 2 – Pitch & Polish (Final Round)

**Time:** 90 minutes total

**Goal:** Develop a complete solution pitch and present it to the panel.

## What Happens:

- Shortlisted teams refine their ideas and complete the PPT (including Technology Used, Implementation, and Impact).
- Each team gets 5 minutes to present + 2 minutes for Q&A.

# **Judging Focus:**

- Innovation & creativity
- Feasibility of the solution
- Presentation clarity & teamwork

## **Rules & Regulations:**

- 1. Each team must have exactly 2 members.
- 2. Problem statement must be **chosen on the spot** (no pre-prepared topics).
- 3. Teams must use the **official PPT format** provided during the event.
- 4. Participants can use **AI tools for research or brainstorming**, but the final idea must be original.
- 5. Internet is allowed for reference only not for using templates or pre-made slides.
- 6. Time limits must be strictly followed for both rounds.
- 7. Judges' decision will be final and binding.

- The **problem statement must be created during the event**; pre-worked topics will be disqualified.

- Judges' decision is final and not open to discussion.
- Organizers may use submitted ideas for official documentation or post-event showcases.

#### **EVENT 2: PROMPTCRAFT**

## Tagline:

Craft Your Vision with a Prompt.

#### **Event Description:**

PromptCraft is a **GenAI-based creative design challenge** that turns imagination into visuals. Participants will receive a **theme on the spot** and must use AI image-generation tools (like DALL-E, Midjourney, Leonardo AI, etc.) to create a **poster purely through text prompts**. Your words are your paintbrush — craft a prompt that tells a story through art.

#### **Event Duration:**

Total – 2 Hours

## Round 1 - Theme Reveal & Prompt Creation

Time: 45 minutes

**Goal:** Create your prompt, test variations, and finalize the best Al-generated design.

#### **What Happens:**

- Participants get a theme on the spot.
- They experiment with different AI tools to bring their idea to life through prompts.
- The prompt used for the final design must be submitted along with the poster.

### **Judging Focus:**

- Creativity of prompt
- Originality of concept
- Relevance to theme

# Round 2 - Poster Showcase & Caption Writing

**Time:** 60 minutes total

**Goal:** Refine, caption, and present your poster.

# What Happens:

- Participants finalize their design and write a short caption/title for context.
- · Posters are submitted digitally.
- Top entries are showcased for evaluation.

# **Judging Focus:**

- Visual appeal
- Prompt effectiveness
- Relevance to theme
- Caption creativity

### **Rules & Regulations:**

- 1. Solo participation only.
- 2. Theme will be announced on the spot.
- 3. Poster must be generated using **AI image tools only** no manual illustrations.
- 4. Participants must submit:
  - The final AI-generated image
  - The **exact text prompt** used
- 5. Minor edits (text, color, or layout) are allowed but no external assets.
- 6. The use of copyrighted or pre-made designs will result in disqualification.
- 7. Participants must finish and submit within the given time.

### **Judging Criteria:**

- Judges' decision will be final and binding.
